



## **Blue Crush Volleyball Club Code of Conduct for Coaching Staff**

The basic principles of the Blue Crush Volleyball Club (“BCVBC”) stand for the highest ideals in sportsmanship. One of the primary objectives of competition is to develop and foster respect for fellow participants, coaches, officials and spectators. With this in mind, this Code of Conduct has been adopted.

Coaches shall recognize their responsibility for proper conduct at any tournament, contest or event. Proper conduct includes, but is not limited to:

- Refrain from all profane, vulgar language
- Demonstrate good sportsmanship
- Treat all officials, coaches, and spectators with respect
- Refrain from malicious destruction or theft of any club or individual’s equipment or property
- Your players must refrain from the use of or possession of alcoholic beverages, all forms of tobacco, and drugs, narcotics and hallucinating agents.

Any violation(s) to the Code of Conduct will result in disciplinary action. The disciplinary action may result in the suspension or dismissal of the coach from the team for the remainder of the sport season and/or suspension from future competition.

Dismissal from a team or suspension from future competition will be made only after discussion and between the BCVBC Board of Directors, the coach and other parties involved, which could be: a parent, another club’s Club Director, the Director of Officials, etc. All dismissal actions will be conducted in accordance with due process procedures, which involve coaches. All actions could also include loss of salary and expense reimbursement of the tournament which they were attending.
